Group stage

The first round, or group stage, saw the sixteen teams divided into four groups of four teams. Each group was a **round-robin** of six games, where each team played one match against each of the other teams in the same group. Teams were awarded three points for a win, one point for a draw and none for a defeat.

The teams finishing first and second in each group qualified for the quarter-finals, while the bottom two teams in each group were eliminated from the tournament.
